



INTRODUCTION

Integrity is one of Nelsons' core values; we do everything we can to cultivate a culture of integrity. This statement outlines our ongoing commitment to acting ethically in all our business dealings and relationships, and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure modern slavery and human trafficking are not taking place anywhere, across any part of our global business or supply chain.

This strong commitment is reflected in Nelsons' Anti-Slavery & Human Trafficking Policy, any breach of which is taken very seriously.

NELSONS' BUSINESS STRUCTURE

Nelsons' head office is located in Wimbledon, London. We have three subsidiary offices (Boston - USA, Hamburg – Germany, and Monaco), one retail pharmacy (London), and two manufacturing sites (Wimbledon and Snowdonia (Wales)) which comply with EU and US pharmaceutical requirements (including GMP and MHRA and FDA licensed production). We have global distributor partnerships in all our key markets and have distribution in over sixty five countries.

DUE DILIGENCE PROCESSES FOR ANTI-SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk, we have in place systems and policies to:

- Identify and assess potential risk areas in our supply chain;
- Monitor potential risk areas in our supply chain; and
- Protect whistle blowers.

SUPPLIER ADHERENCE TO NELSONS' VALUES & ETHICS

We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking, and a strong pledge towards ethical trading.

We are committed to ensuring there is transparency in our own business and in our approach to tackling modern slavery throughout our supply chain, consistent with our disclosure obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2015. We expect the same high standards from all of our contractors, suppliers and other business partners, and as part of our contracting processes, we include specific prohibitions against the use of forced, compulsory or trafficked labour, or anyone held in slavery or servitude, whether adults or children, and we expect that our suppliers will hold their own suppliers to the same high standards.

We have in place a supply chain audit programme including a supplier selection, qualification and evaluation process, to ensure that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in any part of our global business or supply chain.
